



Who Owns the Problem?

Use this worksheet as directed in the "Group Discipline" training session.

Circle CM for the club member(s) or L for the leader to indicate who owns the problem. Circle NP if there is no problem that needs to be addressed.

CM	L	NP	A club member doesn't want to participate in Game time, but is willing to sit and watch.
CM	L	NP	Every meeting, one club member bounces back and forth between participating well and snapping at the leader and other club members.
CM	L	NP	A club member inhales fumes from the markers every few minutes during skill activities. Other club members don't notice or care.
CM	L	NP	Two partners can't agree on what project to choose during their skill activity.
CM	L	NP	A club member complains that she and her new stepmom can't get along.
CM	L	NP	A club member tells you he feels left out, although you have noticed the others making efforts to include him.
CM	L	NP	An argument between two club members escalates into shoving and shouting.
CM	L	NP	One club member is overbearing, but the others just give in.
