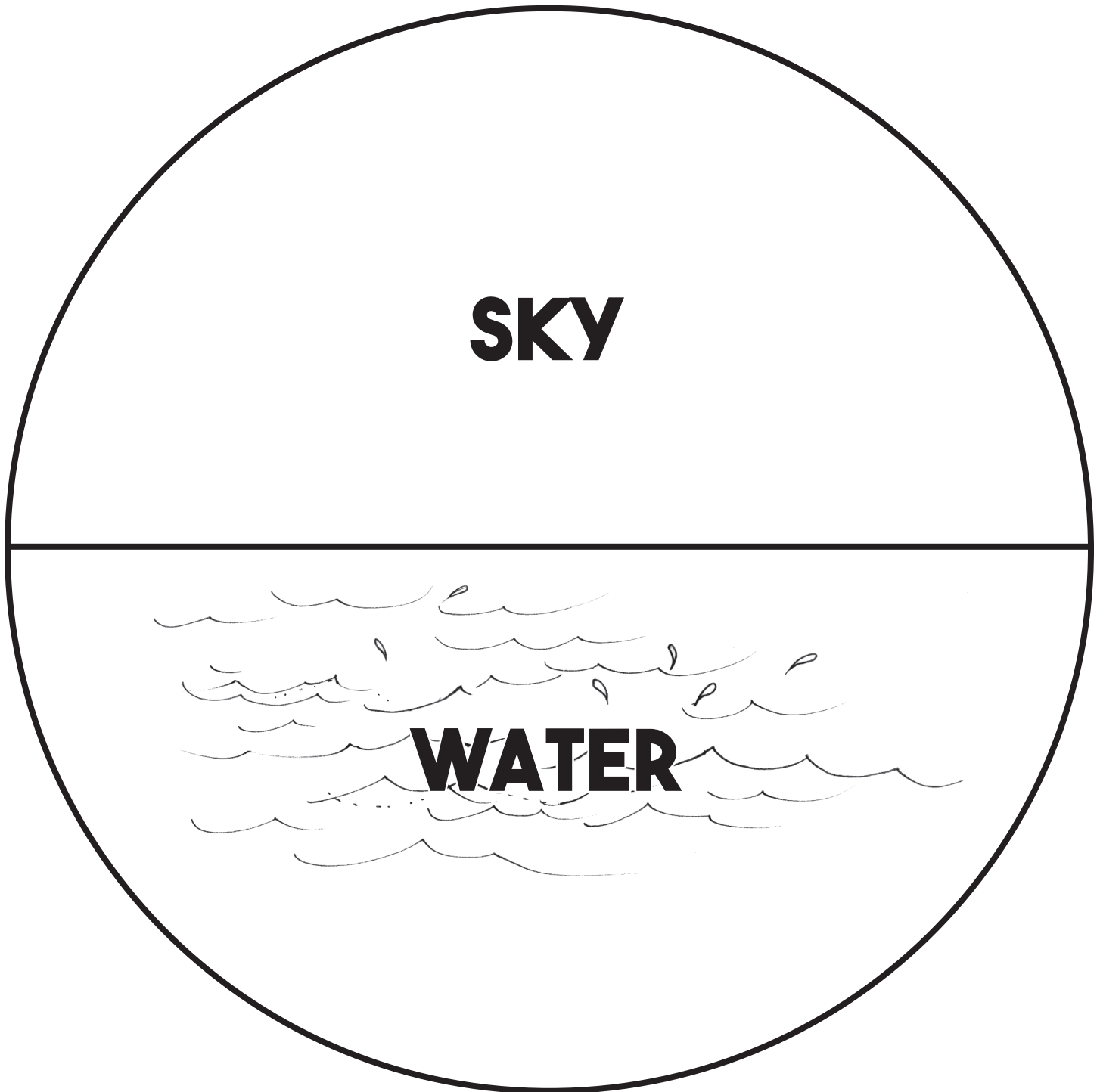


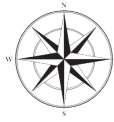
God made the light on Day 1. Circle the images below that provide light.



































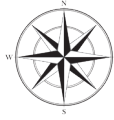
On Day 2, God separated the water and the sky. Color the water dark blue. Color the sky light blue. Glue cotton balls to the sky for clouds.



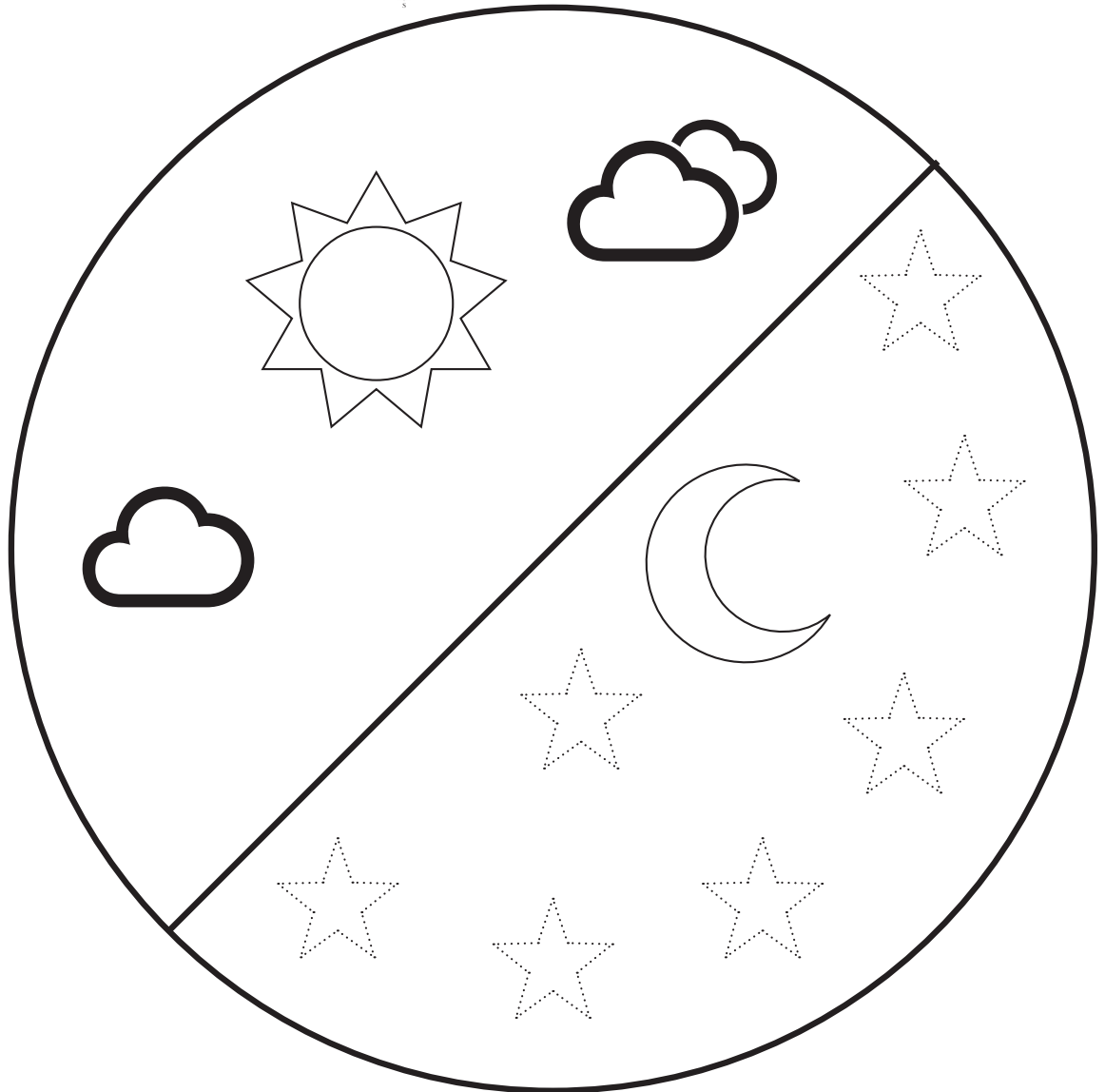

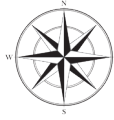




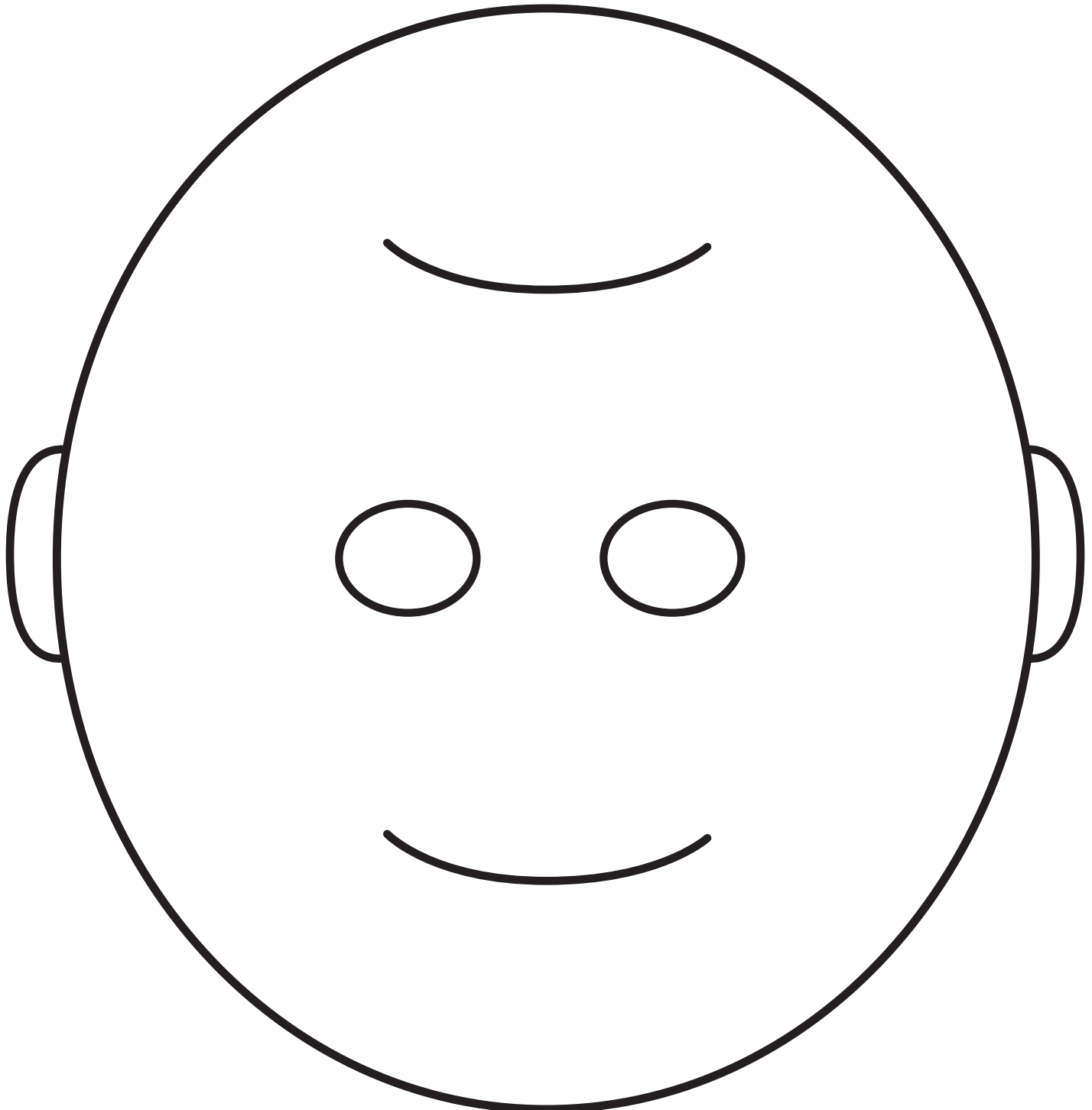


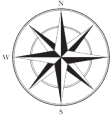
On Day 6, God made animals. Draw lines to match each parent to its child.
